

Camp Dearborn, like all institutions, has been impacted by the COVID-19 outbreak.

In planning for the upcoming camping season, the health and safety of all visitors, campers and staff members has been (and will continue to be) our top priority and the driving force in the establishment of this season's operational processes, procedures and restrictions.

For many of us, Camp Dearborn is a very special place, if not a "second home" during the summer. We have fond memories of overnight camping, playing in the sun, friendly evening discussions around the campfire and, most of all, spending time with family and friends.

This summer, we have to balance our desire to create more such memories with the overriding need to protect the health and safety of everyone as best we can from the COVID-19.

At Camp Dearborn, as at similarly popular outdoor facilities, it is challenging—if not difficult—to adhere to CDC and local public health guidelines regarding social distancing. Camp Dearborn management, though, is committed to doing all it can to protect the health and safety of everyone. As a result, we've made several necessary changes to our normal in-season operation. We may make more as we adjust to this very fluid situation.

### **Changes for the 2020 Camping Season**

Off-season rates will be charged to all overnight campers during the upcoming season. Campers who have already paid in-season rates will be issued a refund for the difference.

Camp Dearborn will, unfortunately, be unable to honor TV1 camping reservations prior to June 8.\* Reservation holders will receive full refunds, including their nonrefundable reservation fee. If a reservation extends past June 7,\* arrival dates will be adjusted to June 8; and reservation holders will receive a refund for the canceled nights. Reservation holders will receive an email notification once the cancellation is processed. Refunds will be applied to the original payment method.

New TV1 reservations will be accepted beginning May 26. We anticipate cabins—both resort and rustic—will be available beginning June 8\* as will full hook-up, electric-only and primitive camp sites.

Camp Dearborn-provided tents will not be available this summer. Campers with existing reservations will be offered the following options:

- Keep their current reservation, bring in their own tent and erect it next to the tent pad. Campers would have use of cabana and electricity (stovetop, mini-fridge).
- Cost: \$32/night and \$145/week with the remaining balance either refunded or applied to a 2021 reservation.
- Receive a full refund.
- Reserve their site for the 2021 season and apply the credit from 2020.

TV2 is closed until further notice. Payments for the 2020 summer season are not currently being accepted. Late fees will not apply, and the 2020 summer season payment will be prorated once TV2 opens.

Beginning Monday, May 18, 2020, TV2 trailer owners will be permitted limited access to their trailer for the **sole** purposes of removing their trailer from camp or obtaining belongings. Yard work and trailer exterior cleaning **will not be** permitted during this time. All trailer owners must sign in and sign out at the Camp Office and provide a photo ID to receive a visitor's pass. Due to the volume of requests and social distancing guidelines, there will be limited number of visitor's passes available per hour. TV2 trailer owners will be permitted one (1) hour of access into TV2. Pre-reservations for access are recommended. To reserve a time, please send an email to [Campdearborn48@gmail.com](mailto:Campdearborn48@gmail.com). Please list the Trailer Owners Name, Site #, Date(s) requested, and time. Due to the limited amount of passes available, please provide multiple dates. Reservations will be awarded in order based on time received. Comfort stations will be unavailable during this time. Trailer visitation is available Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. TV2 visitor passes will only be provided to TV2 lease agreement holders who are not in arrears.

The **outdoor pool** will not open in 2020.

The **Zip Line** will not open in 2020.

**Adventure Golf** is scheduled to open on July 1.\*

The **Rec Field** is closed for the 2020 season.

The **Canteen** is scheduled to open June 8.\*

Nightly **dances** at the Canteen are canceled until further notice.

All lakes will be available for fishing. Non-motorized boating will be allowed where permitted. Beaches will be open as State/Local mandates and CDC Guidelines permit.

Guests entering the **Camp Office** are expected to wear a face shield, and social distancing guidelines will be enforced. A limited number of guests will be permitted entry at any one time.

We ask all our guests to enjoy Camp Dearborn but to do it safely and responsibly and to follow the CDC guidelines (<https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/daily-life-coping/visitors.html>) to help prevent the spread of COVID-19.

We apologize in advance for the inconvenience that these changes will cause, and we're hopeful that these measures will be temporary and short-term.
